Youth Program Application

Application Guidelines:

~Applicants must live in Colorado or Wyoming and be 18 years or younger.

~Applicants must be the primary handler for the dog in agility events; specifically, this means the dog must be handled by the junior applicant more than 50% of the time.

~Each applicant is eligible to receive \$150 per calendar year and may reapply until that amount is reached.

~Money awarded to the applicant is to be used solely for agility lessons, agility seminars, agility matches, or agility trial entry fees. Checks will be sent to the event sponsor or lesson instructor.

~In the event the applicant is unable to take or complete a lesson, seminar, match or trial after receiving the money, the applicant must reimburse FRAC for that amount within 30 days of the missed event and notify the FRAC Youth Program Coordinator.

Approval will take 4-8 weeks to process and grants are awarded at the discretion of the Program Coordinator and Board of Directors.
